We love counting, playing games and singing songs to help us learn about numbers, shapes and patterns. We use real objects in our maths activities, so they are very practical and lots of fun!



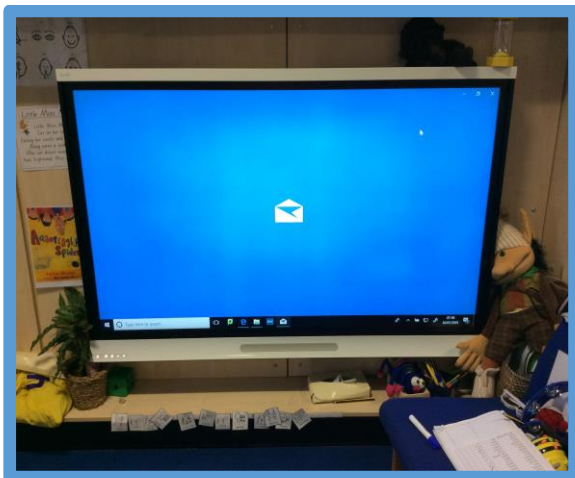
Reading, Writing and Mark-Making
